The Castle Hills Schools Foundation, Inc., was founded to support educational experiences for students residing in the subdivision of Castle Hills. According to our Charter: "The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the primary purpose of the Corporation shall be the assistance, development, and maintenance of charitable, scientific, or educational programs or activities, including but not limited to physical, intellectual, social, and early childhood development and education, for those private, religious, and public schools and day care facilities within the Lewisville Independent School District in Denton County, Texas, located or to be located within the boundaries or otherwise serving present or future residents of the subdivision, or subdivisions collectively known as Castle Hills." In furtherance of this mission the Foundation will consider additional grant requests from schools with 201 or more students residing in Castle Hills, Denton County, Texas.

REQUIREMENTS AND RULES:

1. Applicant must meet all the Requirements and Rules to apply for the Castle Hills Schools Foundation Education Enhancement Grant.
2. Applicant must be a non-profit organization and/or registered under section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code.
3. Applicant must have 201 or more students enrolled that reside in the Castle Hills Subdivision, Denton County, Texas.
4. Applicant must provide proof of enrollment as of September 1st of the current school year with the street name (*street number and student name are not required*) for each Castle Hills student. Verification of student count is only required once per school year.
5. Requests must be for educational purposes, which must be detailed in the application.
6. If approved, checks will only be made payable directly to submitting school or submitting school's PTA (PTA must be a registered 501(c)(3)).

REQUESTS AND SUBMISSIONS:

1. Submissions will be reviewed around the 1st and 15th of each month.
2. Submissions will be accepted from the Resident CH Advisory Board, Principal, or PTA (PTA must be a registered 501(c)(3)) of the school with students residing in Castle Hills, Denton County, Texas.
3. The application can be requested via email @ Hello@ch-sf.org
4. Review the Eligibility Criteria to ensure the application is complete.
5. Complete and sign application.
